

What to expect with the purchase of my wood fence

All wood is guaranteed to warp, crack, split and check. This happens substantially more with pine then cedar and can start within days after installation. There is no warranty coverage on wood.

Southern yellow pine

Pine is treated to prevent rotting, insect infection, and deterioration. Pine has an inconsistent grain structure comprised of large inconsistencies in the density of the grains, making it more prone to warping, cracking, and splitting due to expansion and contraction. It will turn gray if not sealed and stained.

We highly recommend that you stain and seal your fence to prevent water from absorbing into the wood and reflect the harmful UV rays. Staining and sealing significantly lowers the chances of warping, splitting, cracking, and deterioration but does not prevent all of it. Wood needs to be at its natural moisture content typically 14% or dry to the touch before staining and sealing the wood. It needs to be dry enough to absorb the stain. Typically, 2 weeks after installed in the summer and possibly months after installed in the winter.

I have fully read the above and understands there is no warranty on warped, cracked, split, or checked wood and Accent Fence is not responsible for repairing or replacing any wood that may do so.
